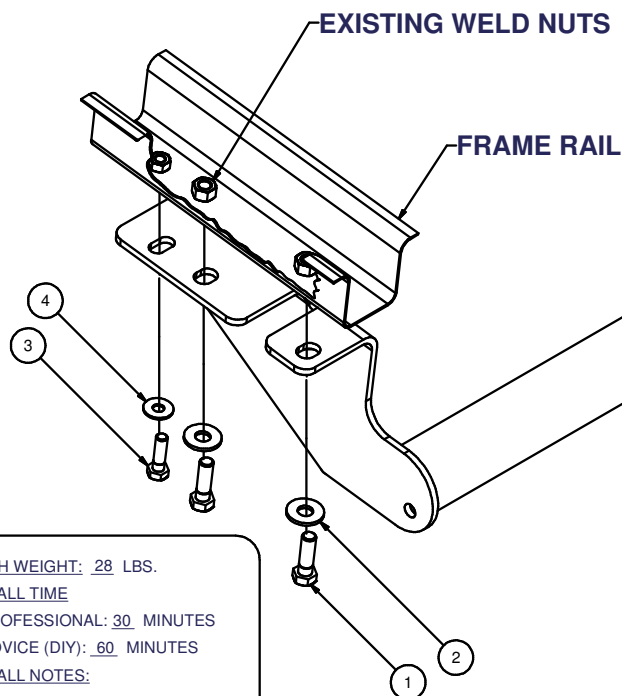
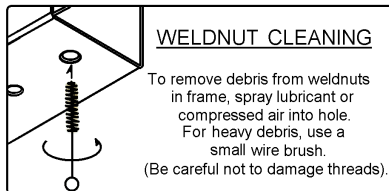

INSTALL NOTES:

- REMOVE TIE DOWN BRACKET
- LOWER EXHAUST
- NO DRILLING REQUIRED

INSTALLATION STEPS

1. Remove the tie down bracket under driver's side frame rail. Lower vehicle's exhaust enough to allow hitch assembly to pass over twin exhaust tips and position under frame rails. Support the exhaust to prevent damage.
2. Use conical washers and metric fasteners to attach hitch under frame rails at existing weld nuts as shown in diagram.
3. Torque M12 fasteners to 86 lb.-ft. Torque M10 fasteners to 48 lb.-ft.
4. Raise exhaust back into position lowered in step 1.

PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS RECEIVER HITCH TO ENSURE THAT ALL FASTENERS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.
